Classes: Division into classes according to ČMKU guidelines (listed below).

TITLES: CAJC CZ, BOJ, CAC CZ, Res. CAC CZ, Winner of Konopiště, BOV, BOB, JBIS, BIS

All published rules applicable for the following titles: Czech Junior Champion, Czech Champion.

COMPETITIONS:

Brace competition – for a female and a male of the same breed with the same owner, judged at the show.

<u>Breeder's Group</u> – at least three individuals of the same breed with the same breeder, having at least two different fathers or mothers, judged at the show.

<u>Junior Handling</u> – Children 4 - 12 years. The demonstration of the dog will be evaluated, their quality is not important.

<u>The Best Stud Dog</u> – the stud dog is shown with at least 3 /at most 5 of his progeny, who were judged at the show. The Breed Type and overall quality of the progeny is judged.

<u>To enter the Show Site the following materials are a must:</u> 1. Dog's Pedigree 2. Dog's health certificate or Pet passport with a proof of vaccination.

3. The Entry Confirmation letter, which is received 7 days prior to the Show.

<u>Veterinary conditions:</u> At the veterinary check-in: the dog's health certificate or passport must be shown with proof of the following vaccinations: rabies. Dogs from EU and other countries must fulfil the conditions specified in the European Parliament Document No. 998/2003 as of this date 26.5.2003.

All these will be checked by the vet at the entrance to the show site.

Application guidelines

One form per dog. Discount for multiple dogs may be claimed only if the name of the owner is identical with the first form. **Each additional change on the second form**, <u>i.e. co-ownership</u>, **shall be considered a new application and the full fee will apply**. Organizers shall not be liable for incorrectly completed entry forms. Should a photocopy of completed

performance trial (certificate) or champion **not** be enclosed with the application, the dog will be placed in **the open class**.

A photocopy or proof of payment of show fee must be affixed to the application. Payments may be paid in the morning before the show starts. Please see fee schedule. Only one application per dog per class. Changing classes after deadline shall not be possible. The exhibitor grants his/her permission to have their address published in the show catalogue.

To be eligible for a respective class, the dog must have completed the applicable trial before the date of the application; this applies for international as well as the respective FCI member national champion title. It is advisable to send entry forms via registered mail in order to have proof of receipt. The organizer shall not be liable for any undelivered applications even if they were sent via registered mail.

General conditions:

All dogs and bitches are eligible if their breeds are entered in the FCI studbooks and are within **the age limit required for the respective class in the day of the show date.**Imported dogs must be recorded in the

Czech Book of Breeds however, the original abbreviation of the book of breeds must be listed on the entry form as well as the entry number of the country of origin. The organizer shall not be liable for any damage caused by the dog or the exhibitor or for the dog's death or loss. Roaming of unleashed dogs shall not be permitted.

Dogs with tendencies to bite or any signs of aggression shall be excused from the show site immediately. The show fees are non-refundable. Bitches in season, highly pregnant bitches, breastfeeding bitches and individuals who have undergone surgery to cosmetically alter the dog's appearance shall not be eligible. It is forbidden to treat the coat or skin with anything that alters the structure, color or form. **Owners with dogs who have won the BOB must be present with their dog during the final competition**. Unless otherwise specified, the provisions of the FCI international show rules and ČMKU rules shall apply. Should the show be cancelled due to objective reasons, all collected fees shall be used to cover show expenses. Bringing puppies and their sale at the venue shall not be permitted.

Complaints:

Objections against any decisions made by a judge shall *not* be permissible. However, formal complaints concerning violation of show rules and provisions may be filed. Such complaint must be submitted in writing with a cash payment of 500,- CZK before the show ends. If the complaint is found not valid, the payment becomes non-refundable. No complaint can be filed or accepted after the show has ended.

The Show Committee can make changes in judges' appointments should any unforeseen difficulties arise. The times for Competitions are approximate only, they can vary.

The judging at the Show is done according to the F.C.I. breed standards and F.C.I. show rules and guidelines. There are classes:

The final judging will take place after the judging in each indiviual ring is completed. These titles will be awarded at the final:

BABY BIS – all the puppies (4 - 6 months) of all breeds, who were awarded **Very Promising 1.** The best of them will receive the title **BABY BIS**.

PUPPY BIS- all the puppies (6–9 months) of all breeds, who were awarded **Very Promising 1.** The best of them will receive the title **PUPPY BIS**.

JUNIOR BIS– all the dogs or bitches (Junior class) of all breeds, who were awarded **Excellent 1,CAJC and Junior BOB.** The best of them will receive the title **JUNIOR BIS**.

VETERAN BIS – all the dogs or bitches (Veteran class) of all breeds, who were awarded **Excellent 1, Veteran BOB.** The best of them will receive the title **Veteran BIS.**

THE WINNER of Konopiště – all the dogs {separate from bitches} and bitches {separate from dogs} in the "adult" classes, ie. middle, open, working, champion, who received the title CAC. This happens for each breed.

BOB – all the dogs and bitches who received following titles and classification: Best Junior, THE SPECIALTY SHOW WINNER and the best Veteran of each breed.

BIS – all dogs and bitches of all breeds who received the title **BOB**.
